Security People Inc. develops its entire portfolio of product lines with the primary goal of minimizing or eliminating the use of non-renewable resources and waste. We make the conscious decision to not utilize any of the *Living Building Challenge Red List Materials* in the manufacture of our product lines.

The Living Building Challenge Red List outlines the following chemicals:

- Asbestos
- Cadmium
- Chlorinated Polyethylene and Chlorosulfonated Polyethlene43
- Chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs)
- Chloroprene (Neoprene)
- Formaldehyde (added)
- Halogenated Flame Retardants44
- Hydrochlorofluorocarbons (HCFCs)
- Lead (added)
- Mercury
- Petrochemical Fertilizers and Pesticides45
- Phthalates
- Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC)
- Wood treatments containing Creosote, Arsenic or Pentachlorophenol

In addition, our line of lockers utilizes 25% post-consumer recycled content and 28% preconsumer recycled content in its contract manufacture*. No VOC content is realized in the finishes of any of our lock or locker products and these products contain no wood content. All of our products utilize recycled and recyclable packaging so as to significantly reduce solid waste.

Security People Inc. warehouses and offices utilize materials that are renewable, enhance worker productivity and foster environmental stewardship.
